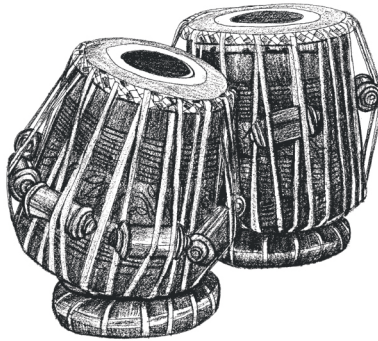

**Harp** is a plucked stringed instrument in which the resonator or belly is perpendicular to the plane of the strings. Harps are roughly triangular.

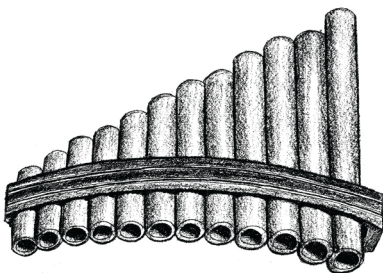

**Veena** is a plucked stringed instrument mainly used in Indian Carnatic Music. The body of Veena is made by joining three parts made of Jackwood.

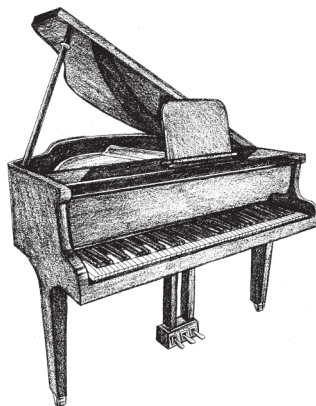
