



BHARAT RATNA THE HIGHEST CIVILIAN AWARD

The Bharat Ratna (Jewel of India), is the highest civilian award of the Republic of India. Instituted on 2nd January 1954, the award is conferred "in recognition of exceptional service/performance of the highest order", without distinction of race, occupation, position or gender. The award was originally limited to achievements in arts, literature, science, and public service, but the government expanded the criteria to include "any field of human endeavour" in December 2011. The recommendations for Bharat Ratna are made by the Prime Minister to the President of India with a maximum of three nominees being awarded per year. Recipients receive a peepal-leaf—shaped medallion and a Sanad (certificate) signed by the President of India.

In order to make it easy for people to make responsible choices for our planet, Sharon Ply undertook several earth-friendly initiatives.

- In Feb 2019, Sharon Ply installed a PET plastic bottle collection & shredding machine at Madurai's Mattuthavani Bus Terminus. Thousands of passengers who use this terminus are now able to recycle their water/juice bottles (after emptying contents).
- In Feb 2019, Sharon Ply installed a REVERSE VENDING MACHINE at Express Avenue Mall, Royapettah, Chennai. This machine accepts PET plastic bottles & cans, and in return, issues coupons that could be redeemed at select food outlets and stores. This machine crushes the collected PET plastic bottles/cans which is gathered and sent to Recycling units.
- In June 2019, Sharon Ply conducted an online contest during the 2019 ICC Cricket World Cup. For every run that Team India scored in the event, Sharon Ply donated an equal number of Tree saplings to the public. A total of 2766 saplings were distributed under this program.
- In July-Aug 2019, Sharon Ply was the Strength Partner of TNPL 2019 and used this
 occasion to spread awareness about caring for the environment. Sharon Ply had put in place
 one plastic-bottle-shredding machine each in the TNPL venues of Dindigul and Tirunelveli.
 Boards had been placed near the shredding machines to encourage public to drop empty
 PET plastic bottles into the machine. Those who did so were also rewarded with a tree
 sapling each. A total of 2000 saplings were distributed during this event.
- In Nov 2019, Sharon Ply installed PET plastic bottle shredding machine at Gandhipuram Bus Terminus, Coimbatore.

(Musician, 1998 Awardee)




